PRODUCT SPECIFICATION

Application	Treatment of timber by brush, course spray or injection
Composition	An aqueous solution containing 5.63% Propiconazole and 1.25% Permethrin
HSE No.	6644
UN No.	3082
Hazard	Classified as HARMFUL under the Chemicals (Hazard Identification and Packaging) Regulations 1996
Appearance	Clear pale straw-coloured liquid with a mild odour
Coverage	Dilute 1 litres of concentrate with 24 litres of clean water. Apply 2 litre of diluted product per 3 – 4 square metres.

HANDLING/STORAGE

Handling	Avoid contact with eyes and skin. Use PVC gloves, goggles, respirator, protective overalls and footwear.
Exposure	Only to be used by trained operators. No unprotected people or animals should be allowed into treated areas for 1 hour after application and until treated area is dry.
Shelf Life	2 years
Storage	Store in original container with secure lid, in a safe place at ambient temperatures.
Transport	Individual 1 litre packs or boxes of 6 x 1 litre packs
Occupational Limits	Propiconazole – LD50 rat (oral) = 1517mg/kg, LD50 rat (dermal) > 4000mg/kg Permethrin – 0.05mg/kg body weight (acceptable daily intake). Allow 8 hours with maximum ventilation before re-occupation.

ACCIDENTAL RELEASE MEASURES

Spillage	Clean up excess with absorbent material and place in a suitable container for disposal by an authorised waste contractor.
Fire	Product is not flammable. Use water spray, carbon dioxide or foam extinguishers in the event of a fire.
First Aid	Operators are recommended to have available the First Aid manual of either The British Red Cross Society or St John's Ambulance Brigade.
Eyes	Wash with plenty of clean water for at least 10 minutes and seek medical advice.
